Getting to the Venue

From the Road

Driving to the hotel or attendees and presenters who are traveling in-state to the Sheraton Gunter is easy. Simply follow the directions below or to locate this hotel using a GPS navigation system, use the following address:

From East

- Proceed on I-37/State Highway 281 North into downtown.
- Take the Commerce Street Exit and turn left onto Commerce Street.
- Turn right onto Alamo Plaza.
- Continue to Travis Street, and turn left.
- Turn left on St. Mary's Street.
- The entrance to the hotel will be on the left.

From West

- Take Interstate 35 North to I-37 South.
- Exit at Commerce Street, and turn right.
- Continue to Navarro Street, and turn right.
- Turn left on Travis Street.
- Follow to St. Mary's Street, and turn left.
- The hotel is on the left.

From Interstate 37 South

- Exit on Commerce Street, and turn right.
- Proceed to Navarro Street.

From South

- Take I-37 North and exit at Commerce Street.
- Turn left onto Commerce Street.
- Continue to Navarro Street, and turn right.
- Proceed to Travis Street, and turn left.
- Continue to St. Mary's Street, and turn left.
- The hotel is on the left.

From North

- Travel on Interstate 10 West until you come to Interstate 37 North.
- Proceed on I-37 North and exit at Commerce Street.
- Turn right onto Commerce Street.
- Turn right onto Navarro Street.
- Continue to Travis Street and turn left.
- Proceed to St. Mary's Street, and the hotel is on the left.

From the Airport

The San Antonio airport is approximately 9 miles away from the Sheraton Gunter Hotel. Travel time to and from the airport to the venue is roughly 20 minutes (depending on traffic).

The Sheraton Grunter does not offer a shuttle from the airport to the hotel. However, listed below are links to help you get from the airport to the hotel.

Via Metropolitan Transport

The most cost-efficient option from getting from the airport to the hotel is San Antonio's bus system. To get downtown (where the Gunter is) from the airport:

- Go to the Lower Roadway (Arrivals/Baggage Level in Terminal A and B), across the marked crosswalk to the outer curb.
- VIA's bus stop will be located on the far West end of Terminal B, clearly marked on column.
- You will board the VIA bus route 5, which operates everyday*, and can get to beautiful downtown San Antonio in about 30 minutes for only \$1.30

Via Shuttle Company

Star Shuttle and Charter is a good transportation option for larger groups or those who want to book an airport shuttle. Star Shuttle offers vans (holds up to 56 passengers) as well as minibuses (holds up to 29 passengers) along with a standard van (holds between 4-14 passengers) that they advertise as an airport shuttle. **Unfortunately, this shuttle service is not associated with the Sheraton Grunter Hotel and is not free.**

Therefore, if attendees choose to use the airport's personal shuttle service, make sure to click the link below before arriving in San Antonio to schedule funds and drop off/pick up times accordingly!
